Planning, Managing and Evaluating Group Housing Systems

Purpose:

 To case-study changes from stalled systems to group sow systems that meet welfare requirements and expectations for managing dry sows.

Take home messages:

- · Each case study outlined very different systems
- Producers selected systems which suited their requirements after investigating various options
- A producer must take into account:
 - · Farm specific requirements for converting from stalls to group housing
 - That different feeding systems are suited to different housing systems
 - That staff must be trained and engaged properly to enable day-to-day husbandry requirements
 - · Extensive planning reduces production losses
 - The need for existing state and local planning/licensing requirements.
