Purpose:

This portfolio addresses industry challenges outlined in APL's 2010–2015 Strategic
Plan under Core Objective 2 Viable Productive Farms and Core Objective 5 Industry
Cohesion and Responsiveness, particularly, building skills and capability, engaging and
connecting the industry, facilitating rapid uptake of information and technology, and
enhancing the reputation and effectiveness of APL.

R&D Priorities:

- Bringing influencers together
 - APL will host and sponsor a range of events which enable interaction among stakeholders and collection and processing of information on outcomes/technologies
- Facilitating technology transfer and adoption
 - APL will use a range of complementary channels to reach stakeholders which will increase the likelihood of R&D messages getting through and action being taken
- Fostering new capability
 - Supporting and informing potential 'recruits' of opportunities in the industry is a crucial first step in influencing perception and addressing labour shortage
- Building technical capacity
 - Producers looking to build the skills and knowledge of stockpeople and provide management training for supervisors will have access to industry-relevant resources
- Corporate communication and influence
 - APL is able to protect and/or advance the industry's position across a range of areas through its ability to access and utilise current industry information.
